

## Minutes of the Ordinary Meeting held at The Village Hall, Kirby Misperton on Thursday 6 February 2014 at 7.45pm

Present Councillors K Sanders (Chairman), D Corton, K Edmond and P Wicks

Clerk Miss S Brown and 2 members of the public

1. There were no apologies for absence
2. Declarations of interest were received from all Councillors due to their proximity to the planning application in respect of the Waste Transfer Station
3. Minutes and Matters arising:
  - a) The minutes of the Meeting held on 26 November 2013 were approved
  - d) There were no matters arising from the meeting 26 November 2013
4. No members of the public made representation in respect of the items of business on the agenda
5. Planning

The Council considered planning applications received:

[NY/2013/0396/FUL](#) Construction of a Waste Transfer Station and associated Staff Welfare Building along with associated local highway improvements

Council raised concerns that the plans submitted differed in respect of the road improvements considered under the consultation process and although had no major objections would be mindful of the increase in daytime traffic and the shorter improvement section included on the current application

6. The Council noted that Ryedale District Council approved planning application [13/01180/FUL](#) Installation of 6 banks of ground mounted solar panels (204 in total) creating a 50kw peak renewable energy system to generate electricity for the caravan site | Land At Ashfield Caravan Park Main Street Kirby Misperton Malton North Yorkshire

The additional condition being that unless written approval sought the solar array must be removed if not used for electricity generation for a continuous period of 3 months

7. To consider financial matters
  - a) The Council received financial statements in respect of the current year activity and projected expenditure to year end.
  - b) The Council agreed payments to be made in respect of the cheque list.

8. Staffing

The Council noted the hours worked by the clerk from 26 November 2013 to 5 February 2014 22 hours

The Council received the Parish Plan questionnaire and discussed the circulating and return of the document

10 Policy and Procedure

a) The Council received the revised Standing Orders and deferred the discussion of the highlighted areas to the next meeting

b) The Council received the calendar for dates of the meetings 2014/15 and agreed the date of the Parish Meeting for 16 May 2014

11 Correspondence

The Council received notification from Ryedale District Council regarding Hardings Yard and information from the YLCA Branch meeting

12 Cllr Wicks reported 49 visits to the web site in January

13 The Clerk reported the receipt of the Winter Weather Grant of £250

14 The Chairman was asked about ongoing maintenance and footpath clearance – the Clerk was asked to follow this up with both NYCC and RDC

A member of the public raised a further issue linking to this query advising of an abandoned sign near the bridge outgoing from the village to main road – the Clerk to investigate
