 - d. [12/00170/OHL](#) Erection of 430m of 3 x 50mm AAAC conductor 33,000 volts (initial operation 11,000 volts) and 6 additional wooden poles and 5 stays, together with dismantling of existing section of overhead line | West Lodge To Poultry Farm Kirby Misperton Malton North Yorkshire
