

# **Minutes of the General Meeting of the Kirby Misperton Parish Council**

**Held on Tuesday 31 January 2012**

He is also a member of Raising Cycling in Ryedale, an organisation to promote cycling in Ryedale. Sustrans coordinate the cycling network in Britain. North Yorkshire has been identified as an area for development. The group has been working in the south of the area – the wolds area and are now bringing the route ways into Norton and beyond.

They are working to promote a link between Malton and Pickering. The proposed route passes through Lendal's Farm. It would be preferable to remove the dog leg and bring the route into the village closer to Flamingo Land, missing out the busy road stretch. This would need access permission to be given from Flamingo Land. This route would become part of the National Cycle Network. Permission will be sought from the Highways Agency and full signage will be erected along the route.
