

Minutes of the additional meeting of Kirby Misperton Parish Council held in the Village Hall, Kirby Misperton on Monday 16 February 2015 at 7.30pm

Present; Cllrs Wicks (Chairman), Corton, Dussold, Edmonds and Saunders

Also present – S Brown (Clerk) and 11 members of the public

1. There were no apologies for absence.

2. Declarations of Interest in items on the agenda

Declarations of Interest in items on the agenda were received from Cllrs Wicks (Chairman), Dussold, Edmonds and Sanders

The Proper Officer instructed that as the interest was currently non fiduciary and the operation of the Parish Council would be restricted it was in the best interest of the electorate for the meeting to continue.

3. Minutes and Matters arising:

a) The minutes of the meeting held on 6 January 2015 were received and approved

b) There were no matters arising from the meetings of 6 January 2015

4. Members of the public made representation regarding the state of the pavements both outside Orchard House (where a MOP reported having fallen and sustaining severe bruising) and between Flamingo Land and the “new” cemetery.

Council requested that the Clerk contact NYCC to report these issues.

5. Planning –

[NY/2015/0029/SCO](#) request for an EIA Scoping Opinion in respect of proposed development to hydraulically stimulate and test geological formations from five discrete zones, at depths between 7,000 and 10,000 ft below ground level, followed by the production of gas from one or more of the formations into existing production facilities

The Council accepted the consultation document and requested that full EIA Scoping Opinion be undertaken prior to the planning application for inclusion in entirety

The Council noted the refusal of the application

6. The Council discussed publication methods for specific articles within government sites and after noting advice from RDC legal department agreed that some redesign of the website should take place presenting links to local Council sites Home Page be made more prominent to assist users

Cllr Wicks advised that this may require some redesign and is to contact RDC regarding this

7. Questionnaire resultant from the Third Energy Resident consultation document
 - a) The Council noted that 64% of electorate did not respond to the questionnaire. From the balance of the responses (34%) 23% of those returning the questionnaires had no concerns regarding the expansion of the KM8 well. 19% of the additional comments raised recorded the fact that although they had no major concerns regarding seismic investigation they did not want it in Kirby Misperton

From the grading of the considerations offered those responding did not have any material differences in opinion on the comments with only a 4% difference in the maxima and minimum areas of grading.

- b) Councillors received the first draft of the analysis as a chart of the responses received

The Council asked that the Clerk reanalyse the data splitting out those who “ranked” the selection and those who “rated” the selection of options.

8. Councillors discussed the participation in a joint parishes liaison group with Third Energy.

Councillors agreed on principle that this was a positive approach and that Terms of Reference and guidance for holding the meeting should be considered prior to full ratification

- 9 Councillors received the election timetable and election papers

- 10 Cllr Wicks reported that there are still some technical issues with the web site.

Cllr Sanders reported that the Parish Plan is making progress but still has work to be done prior to the draft publication being received.

- 11 Councillors received information and correspondence from the Clerk in respect of the receipt of changes to Common Rights legislation and asked the Clerk to check that no Common Land issues affected the Village
- 12 The Chair requested an agenda item regarding s106 monies still being held by RDC and suggestions as to its use to benefit the Village
