

Minutes for the Ordinary Meeting of the Kirby Misperton Parish Council held at The Village Hall, Kirby Misperton on Tuesday 26 September 2017 at 7.30pm

Present Cllrs Corton (Chairman), Bloom, Dussold and Edmonds

Also, present S Brown (Clerk) and 6 members of the public.

Attendees to the meeting were reminded that presentations and discussions will be limited in time as per Standing Orders.

- 1 There were no apologies for absence
- 2 There were no Declarations of Interest in items on the agenda
- 3 Minutes and Matters arising:
 - a) The minutes of the meeting held on 25 July 2017 and 31 August 2017
 - b) There were no matters arising from the meeting 25 July 2017 and 31 August 2017 not covered elsewhere on the agenda
- 4 A member of the public introduced a query which they were hoping to ask a representative of Third Energy a question via the Parish Council. The member of the public requested that an inquiry regarding the provisions of monies be validated and informed to the village.

The Council requested that the Clerk include this as an agenda item for the next meeting

- 5 The Council welcomed PC Paul Storey to Councillors and public members present.

Information was provided regarding his role in the community regarding all related elements of "Operation Kingfisher".

- 6 Planning (and related items)
 - a) The Council noted that no planning applications have been received by the Clerk from NYCC and Ryedale District Council since the publication of the agenda for the previous meeting
 - b) The Council noted planning applications pending from NYCC and Ryedale District Council since the publication of the agenda for May 2017 meeting

- d) To consider additional areas of information from the EA that Council feel would be useful in ongoing consultations in the Parish not limited to the KM8 project - This item was deferred from the previous ordinary meeting and no confirmation regarding representative attendance has been received.

7 Street lights

- a) The Council noted that no further information regarding the proposed transfer of the street lights owned by Ryedale District Council to the Parish from 1 April 2018 has been received and the meeting scheduled in September was cancelled at short notice.
- b) The Council noted that a number of areas needed to be considered prior to the acceptance of the street lights currently maintained by RDC including;
